In some funeral services, informal eulogies or obituaries act as the Resolutions for Funeral Services. In other case, a more formal approach is

necessary. In any case, a funeral resolution is a rite of passage that is read at a funeral and is officially acknowledged by the church and the family. Then the funeral resolution is stored in the church archives.

End with an official proclamation. Have the church officials acknowledge the resolution with a formal statement. You can also use a Bible verse. Close with the phrase "Humbly submitted by." Have the pastor and board officers sign the resolution. Give a copy to the intended party, and file the original in the church archives
